

Payment Options for Fall 2008

Payment for Fall 2008 classes is due when you register. In order to retain your scheduled classes for the Fall 2008 semester you must do one of the following:

1. Pay your semester charges in full.
2. Have a submitted FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file with NSCC.
3. Sign up for the NSCC payment plan and make your first payment.
4. Submit a letter of intent or purchase order from your employer or other organization, e.g. Mass Rehab or Workman's Compensation, if they are paying your semester charges.

In addition, if you enroll in 9 or more credits, in order to retain your scheduled classes, you **must** either waive or pay for your Student Health Insurance:

If your classes are dropped, because you did not make arrangements as outlined above, NSCC cannot guarantee readmission into the classes, sections or professional program in which you were originally enrolled.
